



# Creating One-Pager Documents

## What is the purpose of the one-pager document editor?

Traditionally, standard PDFs are static – making them tough to edit and personalize. The one-pager document editor addresses these challenges by providing a more flexible design experience with the Drag & Drop Editor. Allowing even a novice user the ability to create visually appealing designs.

Use the one-pager document editor to:

- Refine the layout to align with your preferences.
- Incorporate personalized branding specifications seamlessly.
- Translate your document instantly into over 130 languages.
- Tailor content to suit specific audience segments.
- Build a library of layout designs to use as a starting point.

Upon completion, effortlessly generate your documents in PDF format, providing an excellent way to educate partners and their customers about your offering.

## How do I create them?

Start by copying an existing layout to use as a design framework. Be sure to select a document that mirrors the type of document you want to create. (In other words, the document you create should maintain the same structure as the document you copied). Once copied, update the content and images within the canvas. Always test your pdf before publishing it to Marketing Center.

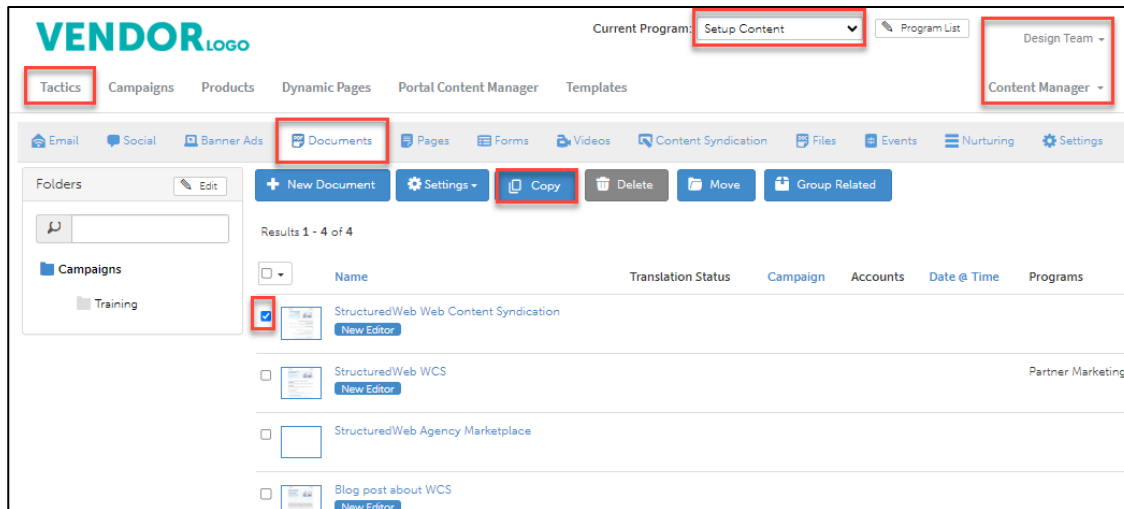

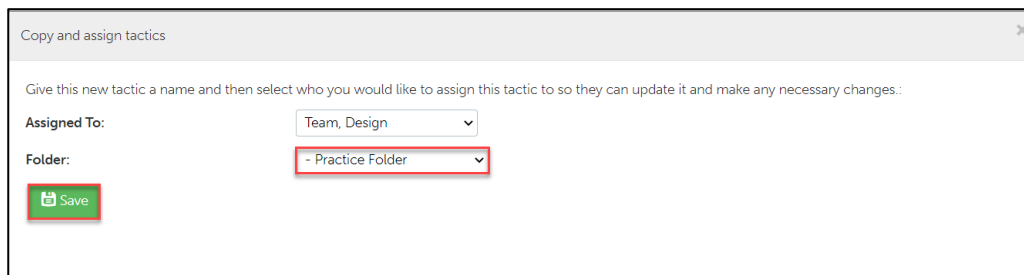
## Steps

### COPY EXISTING DOCUMENT

- 1 In **Content Manager**, from **Current Program**, select **Setup Content**.
- 2 From the **toolbar**, select **Tactics > Documents**. A list of existing documents appear.
- 3 Place a **checkmark** next to the document you want to copy. Then click **Copy**.



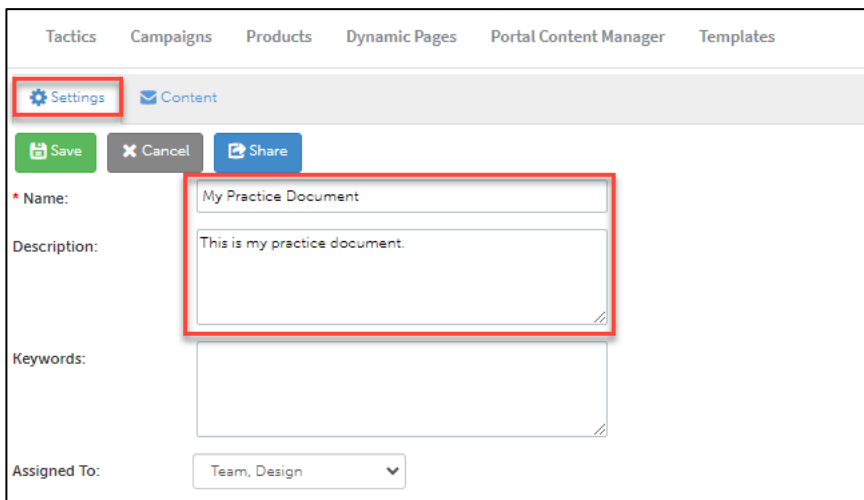
- 4 From the **folder** drop-down menu, select the **folder** to copy your document.



- 5 Click **Save**.

## CREATE DOCUMENT SETTINGS

- 1 From the **Folders** panel, select the **folder** for which you copied the Document. Then select the **document**.
- 2 From the **toolbar**, select **Settings**.
- 3 In the **Name** field, type **My Practice Document**.
- 4 In the **Description** area, type. **This is my practice document**.

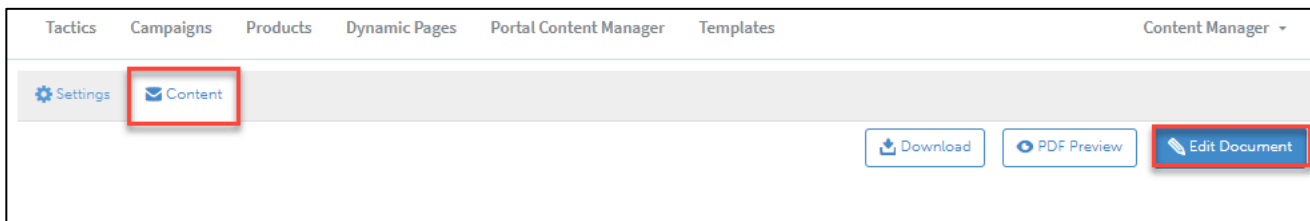

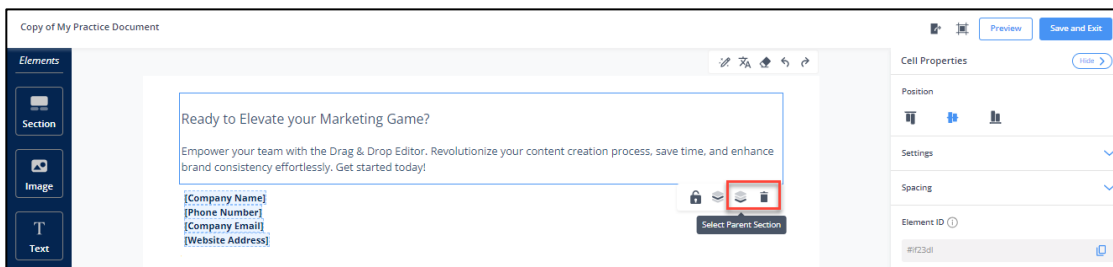

## DELETE BODY CONTENT

- 1 **Note:** To ensure consistency across your content and save time, be sure to retain headers and footer. However, for best results, delete all body content and elements and start from scratch.
- 2 From the **Content** tab, click **Edit Document**.



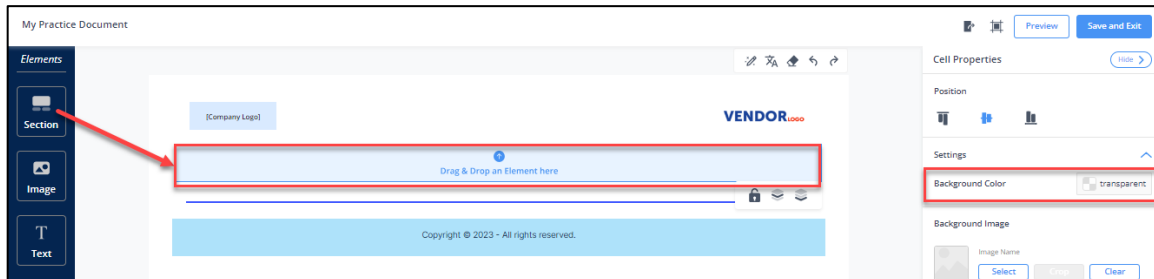
- 3 In the **canvas**, for each **body section**, click the **Select Parent Section** icon.
- 4 Once selected, click the **Delete Element** icon.



- 5 Repeat **steps 2 & 3** until all body content is cleared. (Note: Only the header & footer remain)

## ADD BANNER

- 1 From the **Elements** panel, drag & drop the **Section** element onto the canvas.
- 2 From the **Properties** panel, click the **Settings** drop-down. Then locate **Background Color**.



- 3 Click the **Background Color** option, then in the **Hex** box, type **4058ff**.



- 4 From the **Elements** panel, drag & drop the **Text** element into the section.

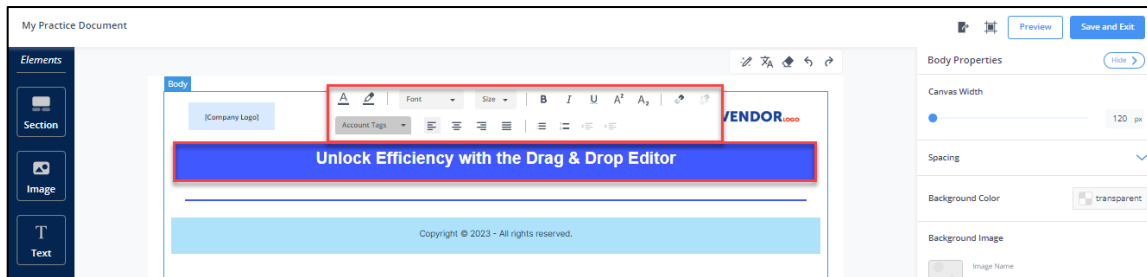


- 5 Double click inside the **Text** box, then copy & paste the following content into the text box: (For best results, copy content into a Notepad document to remove existing formatting.)

### Unlock Efficiency with the Drag & Drop Editor

Using the toolbar, do the following:

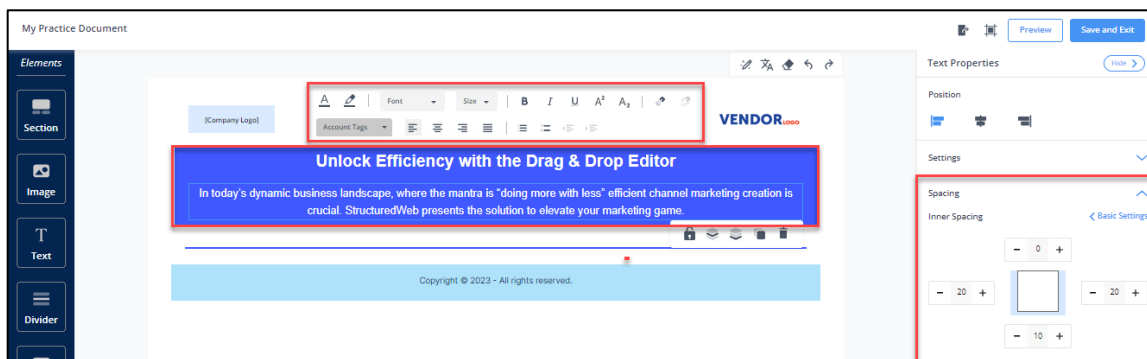
- 6
  - Click the **Center** icon
  - Click the **Bold** icon
  - Click the **Text Color** icon and select **White**.
  - Click the **Size** icon and select 24.



- 7 From the **Elements** panel, drag & drop a second **Text** element into the section.
- 8 Double click inside the **Text** box, then copy & paste the following content into the text box:

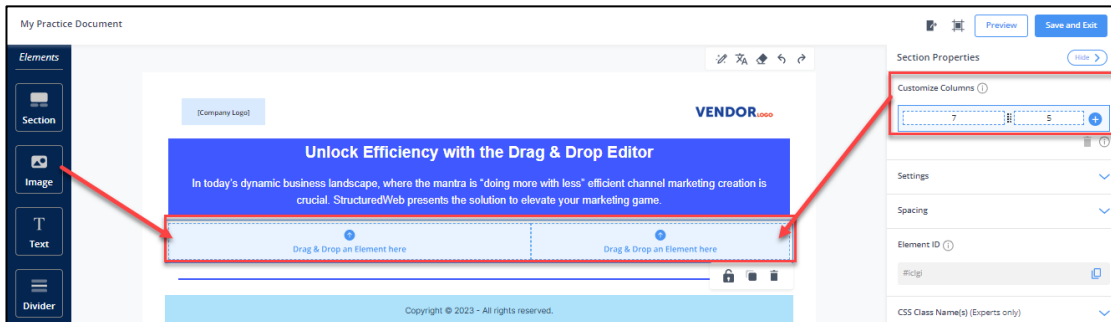

  - From the **Text Properties** panel, in **Spacing > Inner Spacing**, adjust the left & right size to 20.

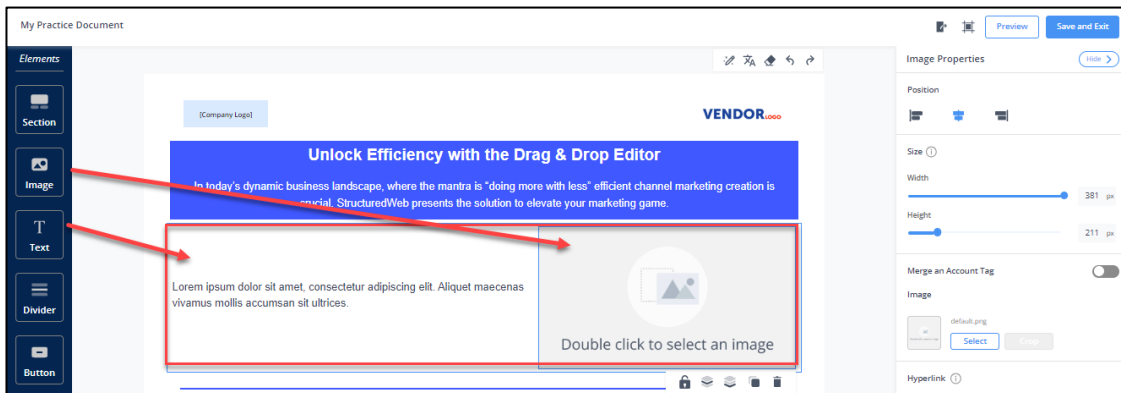


## ADD BODY CONTENT AND IMAGE

- 1 From the **Elements** panel, drag & drop the **Section** element onto the canvas.
- 2 From the **Properties** panel, in **Customize Columns**, click the **+** icon. Then adjust the column size to a **7:5 split**.



- 3 Drag & drop the **Text** element into the left column, and the **Image** element into the right column.



- 4 Double click **inside** the text box, then copy & paste the following content into the text box:

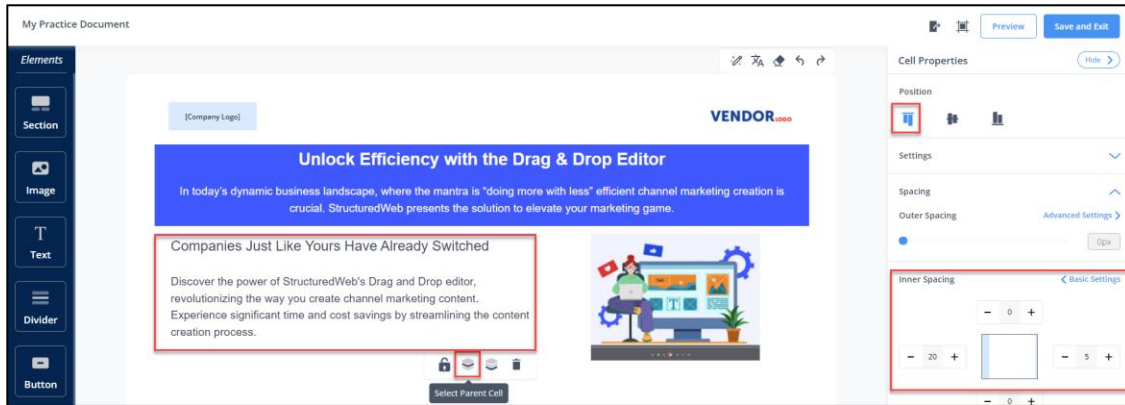

- 5 Highlight **the first row**. Then, from the **toolbar**, click **Size** icon and select **20**.

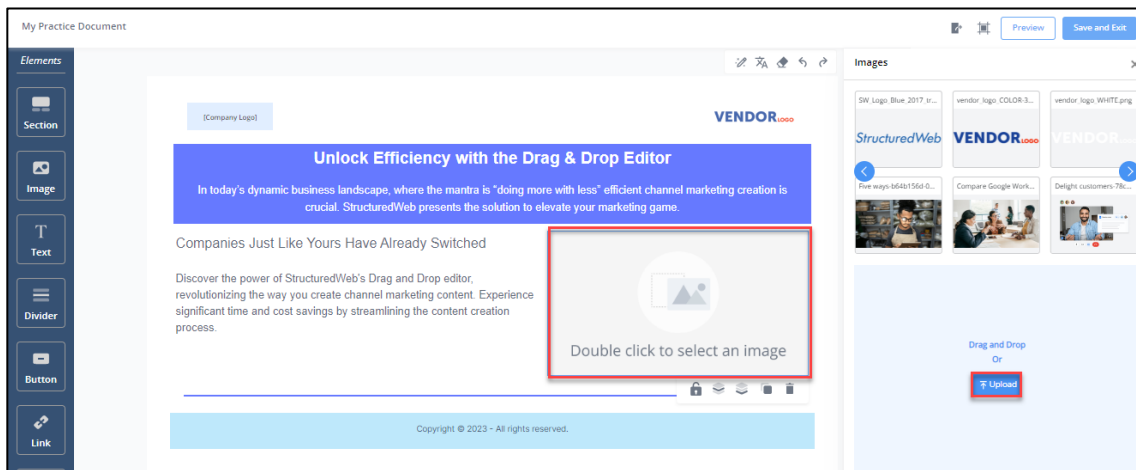


6 Select the **Parent Cell** section. Using the **Properties** panel, do the following:

- In **Position**, click the **top position** icon.
- In **Spacing > Inner Spacing**, adjust the left space to **20** & right space to **5**.

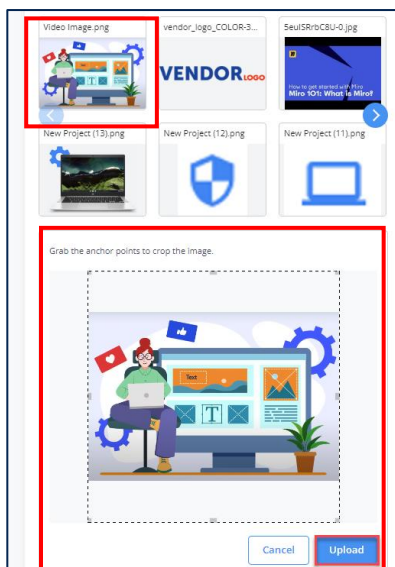


7 Double-click the **Image** element. Then click **Upload**.

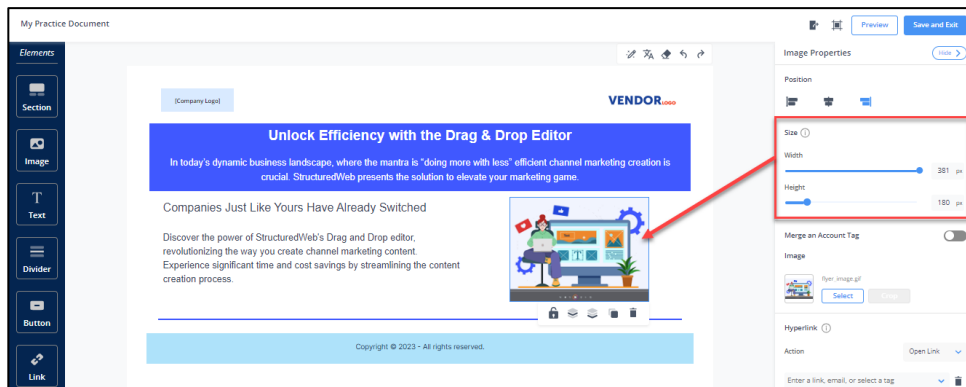


8 Select **VideoImage.png**. Then click **Upload**.

9 From the **Images** library, click the **VideoImage.png** tile.



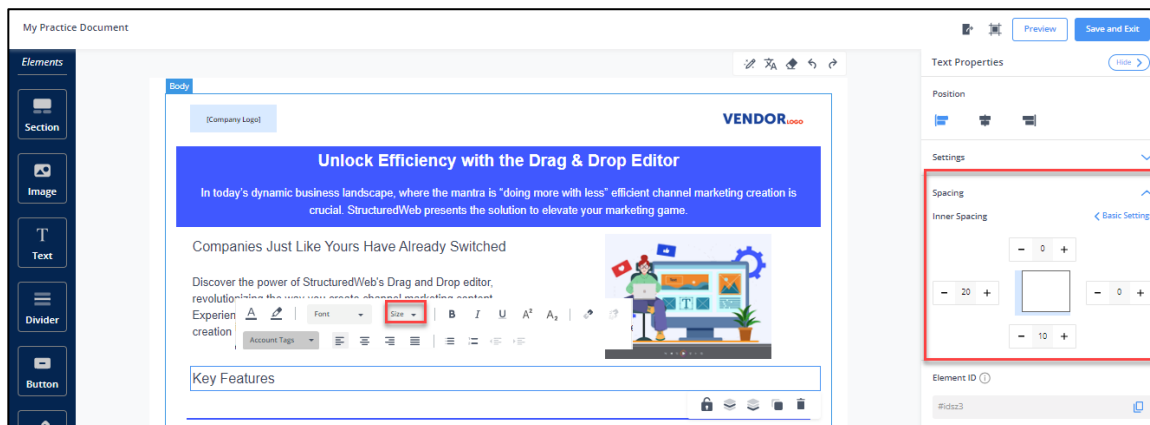
- On the canvas, click the **image**, then from **Image Properties**, increase the **height** to **180px**. (click the slider or type inside the box).



- Drag & drop a **Section** element onto the canvas.
- Drag & drop a **Text** element into the section.
- Double click **inside** the text box, then copy & paste the following content into the text box:

- From the **Properties** panel, In **Spacing > Inner Spacing**, adjust the left space to **20**.



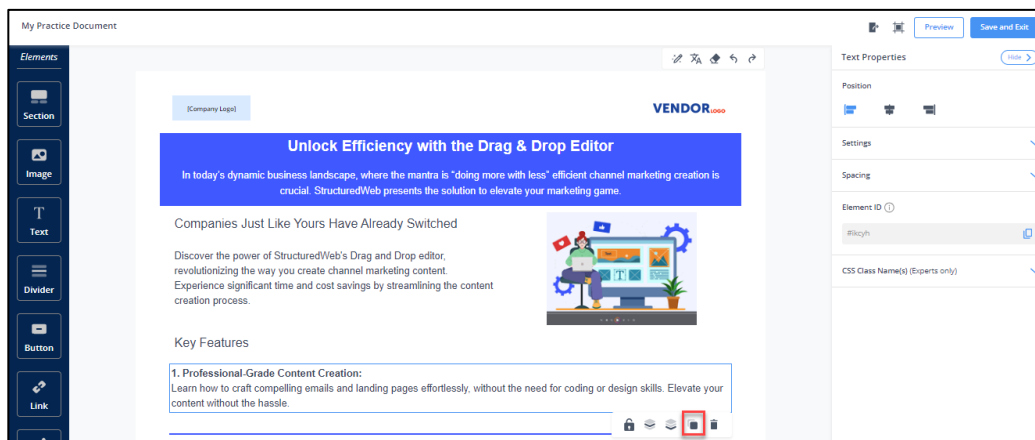
- 16 Drag & drop a second **Text** element into the section.
- 17 Double click **inside** the text box, then copy & paste the following content into the text box:

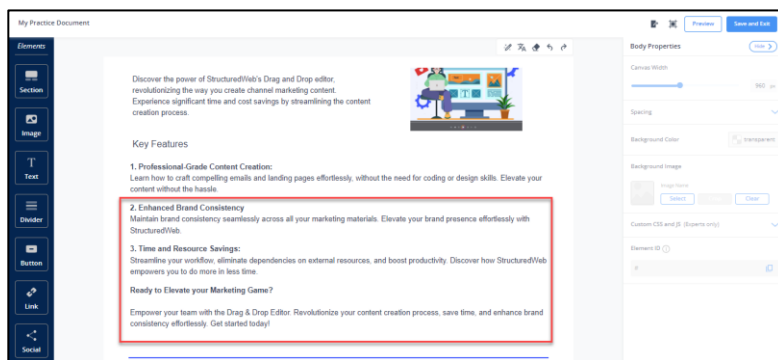

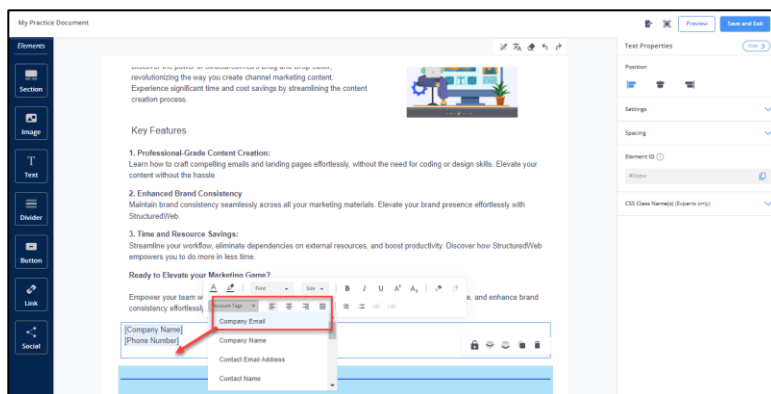


24 Drag & drop a **Section** element onto the canvas.

26 Double click **inside** the text box, then from the **Account** tag drop down menu, select the following account tags

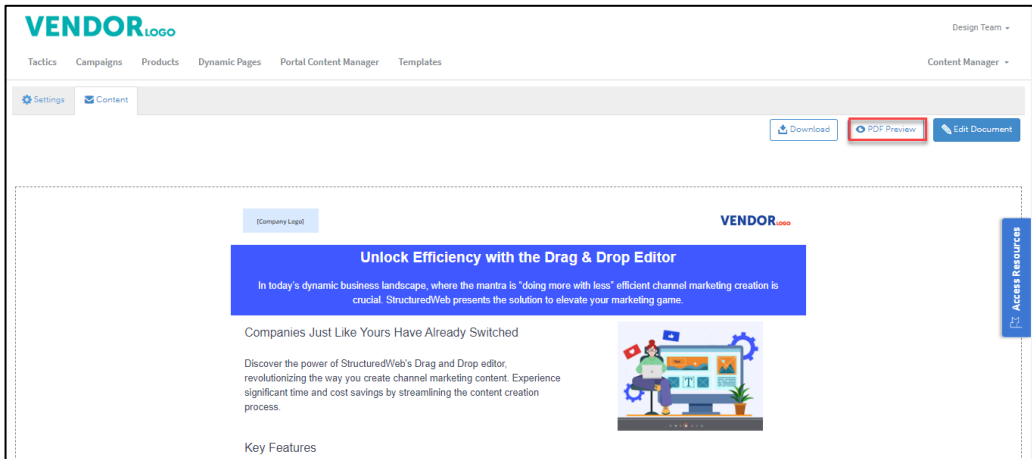

## TEST DOCUMENT

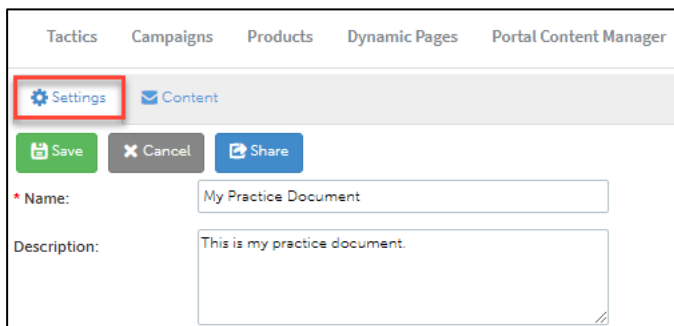
- 1 From the **Document** setup page, click **PDF Preview**. The document opens in a new tab.
